CAUTION!

Possible hearing damage

3 Features

- Connections:
 - 2 lockable NL4 sockets (1+/1- to woofer; 2+/ 2- interconnected)
 - 2 lockable NL4 sockets for system wiring (2+/ 2- to woofer; 1+/1- interconnected)
- 2 × pole mount flanges, (M20), on topside
- Casters optionally available
- Black textured coating



4 Installation

Unpack and carefully check that there is no transportation damage before using the unit. Keep the equipment packaging. To fully protect the device against vibration, dust and moisture during transportation or storage use the original packaging or your own packaging material suitable for transport or storage, respectively.

Establish all connections as long as the unit is switched off. Use the shortest possible highquality cables for all connections.



CAUTION!

Risk of injury due to heavy weight

Due to the heavy weight of the device, at least two persons are required for transport and installation.





NOTICE!

Possible property damage by magnetic fields

Loudspeakers produce a static magnetic field. Therefore, maintain an appropriate distance to devices that can be adversely affected or damaged by an external magnetic field.



4.1 Tips on handling speakers

We recommend you to set up the speakers in a way, that the sound signals can reach the audience unobstructedly. It will often be helpful to mount the speakers on tripods. Thus, the sound will be evenly spread with maximum range throughout the audience area.

Always use high grade cable to connect your equipment. Otherwise you won't reach maximum sound quality.

For optimum results both impedance and power handling of the speakers must match the requirements of the amplifier. Always follow the technical specifications of the speakers! The overall impedance of the connected loudspeakers must not deceed the minimum output impedance of the amp. The amps max. RMS output power should be 50 % above the power handling capacity of the connected speakers.


If you notice distortion during operation, either the amp or the speaker is overloaded. This may permanently damage the amp or the speaker. Always reduce the volume when you hear distortion.

4.2 Connections for wiring method 'Bass to 1'

In order to use the connections for the wiring 'Bass to 1' rotate the connection panel cover in a way that the notches are in horizontal position.




1, 2 NL4 connections, wired in parallel (1+/1- to woofer; 2+/ 2- interconnected)



With this connecting method you can connect the woofer directly using a two-wire cable (wires 1+/1-). If using four-wire cables you can use those kind of top speakers that receive their signals through wires 2+/2- and interconnect wires 1+/1-. The woofer is connected to wires 1+/1- and interconnects wires 2+/2-. The order in which the speakers are connected doesn't matter, but the minimum load impedance of the amplifier must never be deceeded.

NL4 mounting connectors for speaker connections




The drawing alongside shows the pin assignment of the lockable NL4 mounting connectors.



4.3 Connections for wiring method 'Bass to 2'

In order to use the connections for the wiring 'Bass to 2' rotate the connection panel cover in a way that the notches are in vertical position.




3,4 NL4 connections, wired in parallel (2+/ 2- to woofer; 1+/1- interconnected)

These connections allow for a simple wiring using four-wire cables, as the top speakers receive their signal through wires 1+/1- and interconnect wires 2+/2-. The woofer is connected to wires 2+/2- and interconnects wires 1+/1-. The order in which the speakers are connected doesn't matter, but the minimum load impedance of the amplifier must never be deceeded.
